Form Letter Requesting Re-certification

Minority Business Enterprise certification was granted to your business for a period of one (1) year, July 9, 2002 through July 9, 2003. Florida law requires that re-certification be applied for annually thereafter

As of March 31, 2003 the application process for certification and re-certification has changed. The State of Florida has implemented a new electronic Procurement system called MyFloridaMarketPlace. You must register at <https://vendor.myfloridamarketplace.com/> in order to re-certify. Additionally, you must complete the re-certification affidavit located at <http://osd.dms.state.fl.us/apps2.htm> and return it to the Office of Supplier Diversity via U.S. mail to the address listed on the cover page, as this will serve as your supporting documentation.

Rule 38A-2.0061(2), Florida Administrative Code, requires that the Office of Supplier Diversity be in receipt of this affidavit on or before **July 31, 2003**. Failure to do so will automatically result in the expiration of certification and the rescinding of your certified minority business status.

SUBSECTION 287.0943(9), FLORIDA STATUTES, FURTHER REQUIRES THAT "ANY TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OR PERMANENT CHANGE IN THE MANAGEMENT AND DAILY OPERATIONS OF A CERTIFIED MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE WHICH MAY AFFECT CERTIFICATION MUST BE REPORTED TO THE ORIGINAL CERTIFYING JURISDICTION OR ENTITY AND TO THE OFFICE WITHIN 14 DAYS OF THE TRANSFER OR CHANGE TAKING PLACE. IN THE EVENT OF A TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP, THE TRANSFEREE SEEKING TO DO BUSINESS WITH THE STATE AS A CERTIFIED MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR SUCH REPORTING. IN THE EVENT OF A PERMANENT CHANGE IN THE MANAGEMENT AND DAILY OPERATIONS, OWNERS SEEKING TO DO BUSINESS WITH THE STATE AS A CERTIFIED MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REPORTING SUCH CHANGE TO THE OFFICE. ANY PERSON VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR OF THE FIRST DEGREE, PUNISHABLE AS PROVIDED IN S. 775.082 OR S. 775.083, "FLORIDA STATUTES".
