Dear David,

I received the Meeting Minutes of our last meeting on January 24, 2003, and I believe you have a copy of it. I would like to go over items #9 and #13.

First, Item # 9 refers to our recommendation and concern to continue with the road in the project. The environmental issues and their implications in terms of budget and permitting time can greatly delay the completion of the restoration project. We also had a telephone conversation about this, and we were agreed in not to consider the road as part of the scope of work of the project. Please issue a written confirmation to our department and the consultant that The Virginia Key Beach Trust office is agreed to delete the road from the project. Our department will adjust the PFA Form and the scope of work accordingly.

Second, If the road is not in the project, we are considering the possible connection of the sewer line at Rickenbacker Cswy as a better option to avoid environmental impact in the area. This is stated in Item #13 of the Meeting Minutes. Mr. Perez will need a thorough investigation of the point of connection and discuss it with WASD. As per his opinion in the meeting, he does not see a problem in this connection.

If these decisions can be taken and finalized, our estimated time to begin construction at the end of June is on schedule. Thank you for your consideration and support in these issues.
