RESOLUTION NO. 02-1031

A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION, WITH ATTACHMENT(S), APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET OF VIRGINIA KEY BEACH PARK TRUST, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,661,674, AS ATTACHED AND INCORPORATED, TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATIONS, MAINTENANCE AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS OF VIRGINIA KEY BEACH PARK, FOR FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2002 AND ENDING SPETEMBER 30, 2003.

WHEREAS, Section 38-237 of the Code of the City of Miami, Florida, as amended, provides that the Virginia Key Beach Park Trust ("Trust"), shall submit its annual budget for the operations, maintenance and capital improvements of Virginia Key Beach Park ("Park") to the City Commission for approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for Virginia Key Beach Park Trust has been reviewed and approved by the Trust;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The recitals and findings contained in the Preamble to this Resolution are adopted by reference and incorporated as if fully set forth in this Section.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and signature of the Mayor.^{2/}


