FROM THE NORTH – I 95 TO EXIT 1A, TURN LEFT AT THE SECOND INTERSECTION, TRAVEL EAST ACROSS THE RICKENBACKER CAUSEWAY FOR THREE MILES TO THE SECOND TRAFFIC LIGHT, TURN LEFT.

FROM THE SOUTH – US 1 TOWARDS BRICKELL AVENUE, TURN RIGHT AND TRAVEL EAST ACROSS THE RICKENBACKER CAUSEWAY FOR THREE MILES TO THE SECOND TRAFFIC LIGHT, TURN LEFT.
