Building Improvements and Repairs - 2007

The Improvements:

The most serious is roofing work that is needed.



A tour of the roof with Jorge, Chris (CW Construction) and a roofing contractor uncovered standing water. (See Above)



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The conscience was that Regosa Engineering did not add any insulation to the roof and built in no roof pitch to allow for water drainage on the bath house or concession stand. Both buildings have been suffering water damage to their interiors.



The remaining improvements are more cosmetic but could be serious.

The concrete damage on the exterior wall of the carousel building is steadily getting worse. (See above)
