

Virginia Key Beach Park Trust Carousel Operator

This position requires a highly responsible employee performing tasks involving the safe operation of a historic carousel inspection of mechanical devices, operations of mechanical controls, daily physical and visual inspections of the carousel amusement ride, general cleaning and upkeep of the carousel and carousel pavilion before and following daily operation and some general customer service.

This position requires an outgoing employee performing tasks involving public contact, responsibility for the rapid and accurate completion of cash transactions necessary for the general public to come into the historic carousel amusement ride, information dissemination and the safe loading and unloading of the general public.

This employee is responsible for managing amusement ride ticket sales for the carousel and mini train and/or ticket validation and ticket processing when needed. Employee must be extremely careful and accurate in calculating and returning correct change to customers, processing the customer's amusement ride coupon, provide safety rules and information, deliver historical information and context about the amusement and any other information and/or literature.

The position may include supervisory responsibility. The Carousel Operator may be responsible for the supervision of park attendants, assistants or interns in loading and unloading passengers on and off of the carousel. The Operator maintains the schedule of carousel operation, ride speed and ride length. Supervisors are available for resolution of more difficult work problems, malfunctions, mechanical or electrical problems, but the Operator must work with independence, problem solving and sound judgment.

The Operator inspects the cleanliness and condition of the carousel and pavilion area after each ride and keeps work area clean.

Employee will perform related work and other general park attendant duties as required.
