Goals for the upcoming year

- Capital improvement projects for the park grounds will include exotic plant removal, selection of a landscape architect, picnic facilities, a new landscaped entrance road to the beach park, restoration of the historic mini-train and children's play area.
- Capital improvement projects for the park infrastructure include circulation road paving and parking lot improvements, an electrical and water supply master plan and construction and shoreline promenade.
- Capital improvement projects for new park facilities include the relocation
 of the Virginia Key Beach Park Trust administrative offices to the historic
 beach park site. The new offices would provide administrative space until
 the completion of the museum/cultural center slated to open August 2008.
 The installation of the historic carousel, the mini-train passenger station
 and new picnic shelters and pavilions.
- The Virginia Key Beach Park Architectural Competition will select an architectural and design team to develop a museum/Cultural Center design for the facility on Virginia Key Beach Park (October 2005), a final museum design and construction drawings are scheduled for completion (May 2006) and the Trust will break ground on the construction of the museum facility at historic Virginia Key Beach Park in the Summer of 2006.
