## Historic Carousel Timeline

**February 23, 2008** Historic Virginia Key Beach Park re-opens to the public; historic carousel is rented by the Trust from Midwest Midways in Indiana.

**March 3, 2008** Commissioner Marc Sarnoff pledges a \$100,000 matching grant to purchase an Allan Herschell carousel for Historic Virginia Key Beach Park.

**March 5, 2008** The Trust requests a scope change to its remaining Safe Neighborhood Parks (SNP) funds for the purchase of the Allan Herschell historic carousel from Midwest Midways.

**May 1, 2008** SNP Approves scope change to purchase historic carousel. (\$200,000)

**June 10, 2008** The initial payment for the historic carousel was paid. (\$50,000 DCF)

July 7, 2008 The balance of the carousel was paid. (\$200,000 SNP)

**January 23, 2008** The electrical connections to the historic carousel were completed. (\$47,000 HD2)

February 1, 2009 Historic carousel re-opened to the public.

## Historic Carousel Fundraising Timeline

**March 3, 2008** Commissioner Marc Sarnoff pledges a \$100,000 matching grant to purchase an Allan Herschell carousel for Historic Virginia Key Beach Park.

July 7, 2008 The balance of the carousel was paid. (\$200,000)

June 10, 2008 The initial payment for the historic carousel was paid. (\$50,000)
