

2009 SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS BOND PROGRAM, MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION, WITH ATTACHMENT (S), AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING TO THE VIRGINIA KEY BEACH PARK TRUST ("VKBPT"), FOR FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000 FOR THE HISTORIC VIRGINIA KEY BEACH PARK PAVILION PROJECT ("PROJECT"); AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF REQUIRED MATCHING FUNDS OF FIFTY (50%) OF PROJECT COSTS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 FROM CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT B-30174, ENTITLED VIRGINIA KEY BEACH PARK HISTORICAL RESTORATION PHASE TWO; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE ATTACHED FORM, FOR SUBMISSION OF THE VKBPT GRANT APPLICATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010, SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SAID GRANT APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Miami ("City") wishes to purchase and install several shade pavilion structures at Historic Virginia Key Beach Park throughout its public picnic areas ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the Project is estimated not to exceed \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to apply for grant funding from the Safe Neighborhood Parks bond Program (SNP") in the amount of \$50,000 or fifty (50%) of the total Project cost; and

WHEREAS, the City is allocating the matching funds of \$50,000 or (50%) of said amount from Capital Improvement Project B-30174, Entitled Virginia Key Beach Park Historical Restoration Phase Two, in the manner provided herein for this project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The recitals and findings contained in the Preamble to this Resolution are adopted by reference and incorporated as if fully set forth in this Section.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized {1} to submit an application for grant funding to SNP Miami-Dade County, in substantially the attached form, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for the Project, and execute the necessary documents required by SNP, including the Program Agreement, all as are attached hereto, to implement this Resolution.

Section 3. The allocation of required matching funds, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000, from Capital Improvement Project B-30174.

Section 5 This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and signature of the Mayor.{2}
