The Nature and Environment committee meets jointly with the Planning and construction committee on a quarterly basis. Following the Planning and Construction portion of the meeting the Nature and Environment committee's discussion centered on reprogramming Safe Neighborhood Parks (SNP) funds from Planning and construction of a future nature center of Historic Virginia Key Beach Park to planning for the nature center and selective exotic vegetation removal (discussed in the Audit/Budget Committee Report).

The committee discussed the new volunteer participation partnership with Hands on Miami. Through the Hands on Miami Flexible Program the Trust will benefit from monthly volunteer teams to assist Trust staff with exotic vegetation removal, grounds keeping, beach cleanup, potting seedlings and plants, and native plant installation.
