Historic Virginia Key Beach Park was first established in 1945 as the colored only beach during segregation in South Florida; the Historic Beach Park was a popular and joyous recreation space for families during that time.

After closure in 1982 the Historic Beach Park was re-opened in 2008 by the Virginia Key Beach Park Trust which restored and manages the property today.

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the State of Florida Heritage Trail and the City of Miami Historic and Environmental Preservation List - Historic Virginia Key Beach Park invites you and your family to PARADISE RENEWED!
