Dear Judge Farris:

I am enclosing four maps, which we have had made, showing different things with regard to the Everglades. I am sending you these for your inspections and request that you return them to me with whatever remarks you have to make about them.

They are all numbered in the upper left hand corner in black.

Map #1 shows, for purposes of comparison only, the acreage of the State under the Swamp and Overflowed Land Act of 1850. It is impossible to show these lands in their exact location and this is made simply for comparison.

Map #2 shows the Everglades Drainage District.

Map #3 shows the lands owned by the State in March 1916.

Map #4 shows the same thing as Map #3 but is drawn on a map of the State.

I think these are about all the maps we can get, which will serve to illustrate the arguments made.

Please return them to me with your comments.
