Dear Mr. Morgan:-

I am enclosing you application for Charter, Tamiami Railway. I want you to sign same and subscribe to your signature before a Notary, and immediately wire me the name of Notary and the date of expiration of commission, and also immediately file the application for Charter and plat attached thereto, with Secretary of State, H. Clay Crawford, handing him my check in the sum of \$50.00, as enclosed, and I will remit the other \$200.00 to him before Charter is granted.

You will note that I have included your name on the charter for \$2000.00 worth of stock, for which you can pay in future services to the corporation.

Please read the charter carefully and if there are any absolute errors, in other words, anything in it which would not permit Letters Patent being granted, do not hold the charter up by reason of this, but file it with the Secretary of State and we can correct at a later date by amending our charter, or you have authority to red line or insert anything which may be absolutely illegal included in the charter, but I do not think you will find anything which is inconsistent with the law. If there is any illegal feature, wire me just what it is, so that I can correct before it goes to the printer, but I do not want any delay by reason of technicalities.

I am writing you separate letter on drainage matters.
