Dear Mother:

Following from Railway Review, March 2nd, 1918:

FLORIDA:

Tamiami Railway has a survey line established, and has one roadbed machine at work on the line from Miami to a point on Chevalier Bay on the West Coast of Florida, a distance of 60 miles. Construction on a large scale will begin as soon as arrangements can be made. The line will later be extended northwest to Ft. Myers, a distance of about 70 miles. Dock, wharf and other terminal facilities will be available through a connection with the municipally owned railway at Miami. J.F. Jaudon, Miami, is president.
