Yours of the 8th inst, tohand, and note that the Cypress on the Hopkins Tract is at present under option at a price of \$6.00 per 1,000 feet, and also note that you agree to protect the price of \$5.50 per 1,000 feet to our client should the party now holding the option does not close with you for it, I also note that you request that I do not offer this timber to any one else for a less price than \$6.00 per 1,000 feet.

Our client for this timber is the Hebard Cypress Co. with mills at Hebardville, (Ware County) Ga., and with headquarters at Scranton, Pa., these people are the owners of the Timber in the Okenfenokee Swamp, they are amply able to handle your timber if it is open to them and I will appreciate having your advise me as to when the present option expires so that I can advise them and have them ready should your people not close with you for it.

I had this timber up with these people several years ago through Mr. R.R. Hopkins of Brunswick, Ga., and my correspondence with you will show this, also several letters to you from Mr. Hopkins as he stated to me that he had written you relative to this.

I will appreciate having you let me know whether this timber can now be reached by auto either from Miami or Ft. Myers or will you have to go by auto and boat as stated by you in our last conversation, as this has been several months ago I hope that the road from Ft. Myers has now been completed to the timber.
