Dear Fletcher:-

Confirming and relative to our conversation yesterday, we will agree to sell you and you agree to purchase from us all the tie timber whether pine or cypress, standing and down or dead on Section Eight (8) of Township Fifty two (52) South of Range Thirty (30) East which Section is located about one ~~mile~~ half mile east of Immokalee Highway and A.C.L.Ry.

Price for stampage to be fifteen cents (.15 cents) per tie, whether accepted or rejected by by railroad Company.

Sale does not cover fence post nor telegraph or telephone poles.

It is distinctly understood and agreed that no financing will be done by us. We agree to undertake to dispose of said ties if your present arrangement for sales to the Atlantic Coast Line Ry. is terminated or is unsatisfactory. You agreeing to haul all ties out to siding at Copeland Florida or other designated and agreed siding.

It is distinctly understood and agreed that you will not dispose of or permit any removals cut on this property to any person firm or corporation without our written consent.

It is distinctly understood agreed that beginning July 16th 1934 ties will be cut at a rate of not less than seventy-five (75) per day and a minimum of two thousand per month.

We reserve the right to cancel this agreement on ten days notice.

If the above is clearly understood and agreed to by us and by you; kindly sign the original and two copies to this agreement, you retaining one copy for your guidance and protection.
