Dear Capt' Jaudon

Since writing you yesterday of the plan which Mr Cralle has had his Atty' suggest delay coming until, after Xmas- In order to speed up the details necessary to close the deal. I want to suggest you decide the name of the Company, and make out the legal discription of the land, send same to me so I can deliver to Mr Cralle, so when he and his associates bring the deal to close. Cralle can have his Washington Atty' make out the Mortgage which will meet the requirements of the Dept' thru which the deal will be handled, which would put us in shape to execute the mortgage which Cralle can mail direct to you and I feel you will fully appreciate this would save us time and delay as naturally, The Washington Atty' who will handle the details, he would be in position to make out the Mtg' and all necessary papers subject to the approval of the Dept' which will furnish the money and I know this would make it easy to bring to a close and save time and delay in us trying to prepare the necessary papers at this end.

As you know, dealing thith the Government on such matters, they have certain forms of papers which have to be prepared to meet their approval and I think the plan above suggested will save us delay and by having all necessary papers prepared by the Washington Atty' who is familiar with such details, I feel sure such method would save us time and I will thank you to take this matter up with Mr Taylor and I feel sure he will fully appreciate handling the matter as suggested and he can make up the necessary papers, as to name of the Corporation and the legal discription of the land to be used to secure the loan. Will await your reply and if this plan meets yours and Mr Taylors approval, let me have the necessary information so I can deliver same to Mr Cralle before the goes to Washington.
