Well its been raining almost every day, but in spite of this we have planted some deed beds and have some more land ready for more seed, its slow work and I am getting hardened to work.

The sugar cane looks fine, but considerable water on the ground.

Quite a few farmers are getting located on the Collier land north of Deep Lake.

Mr. Gaunt Sr. has been out--- Mr. Gaunt Jr. was married about a month ago and will be out some time next week, they are getting ready to plant a big crop----Janes has left the Company and will plant at Naples and up the Imokalee Road, quite a crop I understand----Bird has sent seed to Mr. Procter who is looking out for them over here, they are going to plant eggplant and pepper seed soon.---Tomatoe seed in about ^{three} six weeks.

I received your letter last week, I have answered all the important letters from Commission houses---I am in a way pleased with them---they may make me change my plans, but the change will be as good as the original idea.

There is little I can ask you to do but the following will help----

1---See J.B. Jeffries in person, I wrote him that we must have some money---he expects you to call.

2---See Dr. J.R. Pearson---I wrote him my desperate condition---he expects you, and will give a check in some amount.

3---Get a quit-claim and cancellation of contract (you can get date, description and data from files) from Marjory Stoneman Douglas---I see she has assigned a part of this contract to Maxion I Manley---so get quit claim from him and wife also, I will guarantee to return to Marjory S. Douglas at least one hundred dollars---may be able to get as much as \$200.00 of course I cant get anything until next spring, but I want to clear taxes etc.

Mrs Jaudon and I both well--Personal regards from us both.
