Let me thank you for your letter (comy) to me and others on this matter.

I have not as yet received the copy of the proceedings of the Commission and your report.

Mr. Ernest F. Coe Executive Chairman was out to see me on yesterday; I told him that your and your Committee's decision was mine and the interest I represent.

He teld me that your report had a reccommendation that the west line of the park would be some seven miles east/ of Turner River; I teld him that this was agreemble to me ALTHO that I thought if enough money could be assembled to include purchases of lands abbutting Turner Riber it would no doubt be fine. BUT that as far as we were conserned Mr. Comelands ideas were ours."
