Dear Mr.Thomas:-

I have just received my first check from the saw mill now cutting pine timber on Section 32.T.S.53 S.Range 31 East, against which you held mortgage.

Will pay this money to the Tax Collector as a payment on the several years omitted taxes and send you receipt; this amount will not cover but a part of the taxes and omitted taxes against Section 32, but as money is received I will continue to apply same on taxes; there is not much timber on this section but it is the first which the saw mill could reach.

Well we farmers down here got a hard lick in the December 13th 1934 freeze, we lost all our crops and some fruit trees were injured; I am not discouraged however and will do my best for you and your interest.
