Dear Capt:

I have your letter with copies of letters you have written, and know you are on the right track, and I have written the Secretary of State about the crop, and have not yet heard,

There has been a bill passed authorizing corporations to resume business on payment of delinquent capital stock tax, which will not amount to a great deal, so we should hear within the next several days.

With all the property in your name that is to be turned over to the corporation, what are we going to do with the income tax lien and the Adams judgment? We will have to work out something on that, and I believe a compromise can be effected between all of them, but we will have to show good title in the corporation before the loan is made.

I talked with Skipper, and he is just as enthusiastic as ever, and he thinks we should have:

1. Complete description of lands covered by photographs of activities, etc.
2. Valuation upon different lands placed by competent, disinterested parties having a knowledge of values in that locality.
3. Statement from sugar experts as to fertility of soil and its adaptability to the raising of cane sugar.
4. Proposition from the Clewiston mill for the grinding of the cane, their charges, expenses, etc.
5. Rate from the Atlantic Coast line Railway on the cane, etc.

Gertrude just received a letter from her mother in Los Angeles

and other sister there, that Mrs. Parkhurst is possibly able to travel, and she is very anxious to go to camp, so we are leaving here next Thursday, early in the morning, and I will drive them north, and stay there over the 4th, and come back, so that I should be back here somewhere around the 8th.

In the meantime, all the information should be secured, and then a prospectus can be made up, and if necessary, I will drive to Washington with Skipper and spend a few days there, getting the loan started.
