Dear Colonel:-

Yours 27th received, think your idea a good one, will prepare and send to Mr. Cralle at his Washington address as soon as he supplies same as follows,-----

KODAK VIEWS----Showing housing for labor etc,

LAND RENTAL VALUES----Just received from Mr.H.W.Bird of H.W.Bird Tomato Corp.a letter setting forth that \$10.00 per acre per year is rental value of lands,that he can and will use from 500 to 1000 acres each season,and that around 2000 acres will be planted in this area anually.

PUERTS RICO TRADE GROUP----I note by the Press that a group of representative men from Puerta Rico is to visit the States on December 4th;I shall endeavor to have several of the sugar cane growers visit our Plantation and get them if possible to give me in writing JUST WHAT THEY THINK in regard to a large sugar operation on our lands.
SUGGEST----That Mr.Cralle try to get in touch with GOVERNOR R.H.GORE who is now in Washington,he is Governor General of Puerta Rico,he might be able to have him promise to have some of the party visit our Plantation----As this party is to be in Fort Myers on December 7th you might be able to have a talk with some of the group who are interested in sugar cane planting in Puerta Rico;get them to come down if possible.

ADDITIONAL MAPS ETC,--Will make same to Mr.Challe when he gives me his Washington address..

Cant think of anything else that will aid Mr/Cralle except will send him several letters as I receive them.
