From the figures and statements that I have given to Major Cralle' they can make up their "set up".

Major Cralle' thinks that they have the financing--we selling them our entire output of sugar cane, juice, sugar, syrup etc at the nominal quoted "market" price.

I really think they have some real people interested, RUPERT is his name-----.

It wont do any harm for you to give them the "full works" , including CHARTER (conditional), tax statement (approximate), incumbrance (in round figures), and opinion (title in Maude and myself, except S.E.26 you; S.W.36 Valmont Corp.
