Third-----Letter from Dr.S.F.Sherwood Senior Biochemist,Washington D.C. Sent you more for the suggestions at top of his letter,also for your information in case you want to call on him.

Fourth-----Clipping relative to Indians;also letter from W.Stanley Hanson relative to Seminoles and sugar cane in this area.

Fifth-----Clipping from The American Eagle--Jan.12th 1933,this will be for referance.

Sixth-----An advance press service about myself,also for your use.

Seventh-----A set of Kodak views showing the lands themselves which we will put under cultivation.

Will get you the map of Collier County,map of the lands,and the Ginsburg report soon as possible.

Presume you would prefer to write up the labor argument yourself-----Remember there are over a thousand laborers who work down here in the winter months,they have to leave here now afterthe tomato season and find work elsewhere.
