3 VAZCANE PROCESS---Also SAMPLES OF THEIR PRODUCT. Showing clearly the utilization of the "BAGASSE" or ground sugar cane pulp; this is similar to CELETEX.

4 Ricardi, Rum, Spirits-----With alcoholic ~~xxx~~ spirits distilled in the United States it must be remembered that the American taste has been won to liquors made from sugar cane.

5 MOLASSES and REFUSE FROM MILL.-----The very highest grade of stock feed is made from same; C.P. CHESTER of Champlain Ill. won the first prize from cattle fed solely on TARKIO MOLASSES FEED.

This is especially important as Florida is fast becoming the breeding ground of beef cattle, BUT there is no economical feed grown here to fatten them for market.
