Dear Friend Josie Billie:-

Received your letter of Aug 9th, so glad to hear from you and that you and all Indian boys and girls are well.

I have not been out here at farm all the time, am staying most of time in Miami.

Told Indian boys here that I had letter from you; they all seem to be well but not much money down here now.

Farmers will start planting crops about November first, some few are planting early eggplant and pepper now.

My sugar cane growing fine, but have not been able to keep it worked out as well as it should be worked.

Captain Tony, Lofton Tigertail, Charlie Tigertail and other Indian boys have stopped here recently; have not seen Wilson Billie nor Frank ~~Syraxx~~ Tiger lately.

Write me when ever you can, hope you come home soon, but very hot and rainy here now.
