

Jaudon Everglades, Florida Dear Captain Jaudon: I have your further letter dated January 17th and I am glad to say that the cane samples which you sent arrvied about the same time and have been analyzed by Mr. Stevens. The result of these analyses, as tabulated by him, are found in the table attached. You will note that the sugar content of numbers 3 and 4 is fairly satisfactory for this time of the year and we would be interested in learning, approximately, what tonnage per acre you are expecting from the field represented by these samples. I regret the change of schedule which will not permit my coming to South Florida as I had thought earlier. I trust that it may be possible for me to do this in the near future, however, and will hope to advise you in advance when I am able to come. I am taking up with Mr. Stevens, our Sugar Cane Agronomist, the matter of supplying you with a limited number of varieties which it might be of interest to try out on your marl land in the Tamiami district.
