Dear Mr. Jones:

You will note from the attached clipping that the lands in Collier and Hendry Counties, which were to have been sold (notice of sale of which I sent you), have been withdrawn from the market, and that the "bids" offered by Mr. Collier were rejected.

This for your information as I had previously written you on this subject.

These lands have no connection with the "Tax Certificate lands at and near Naples, certificates of which you should buy and then proceed to secure "TAX DEEDS" (unfortunately Mr. Barron Collier's representatives P. J. Savel, H. A. Sears, D. W. McLeod and others have already secured a number of Tax Deeds to lots in Naples).

I trust you have already arranged to buy up these certificates, for I think if there is much delay and any indecision that the Clerk of Circuit Court of Collier County will give Mr. Collier the preference.

Am writing Mr. Hartley today in answer to a letter received from him at Oshkosh relative to Mr. Murray an engineer who has had considerable experience with sewage problems here at Miami and other Florida cities.
