In the Miami Herald, under date of Aug.10th, there appeared an article relative to your proposed Tamiami Railroad.


This venture, in my opinion, if combined with a few strong real-estate and lumber dealers,would be the best paying railroad proposition in the South, beyond a question of doubt.
