Dear Sir:

Have just returned from a trip of inspection of the route of Tamiami Railway, having visited Arcadia, Fort Myers, Naples and almost the entire line----I find your letters of September 22nd, 24th and 29th on my desk.

Note that you received my letter of September 17th while you were in New York, and that you arrange financing for us at any time, you say we must cover cost of preliminaries, but I have nothing from you as to this cost.

In your letter of September 29th you enquire if we have our corporation financing and construction permit, and certificate of convenience and necessity, from the Interstate Commerce Commission; I beg to say our amended Charter is being granted, we have the endorsement of Florida Officials and as we do not in any way conflict with existing lines and open an entirely new territory, which is not only agreeable but really actually necessary at this time, hence we are quite sure the Inter State Commerce Commission will not hesitate a moment in issuing their full consent, approval, and the certificates.

Mr. P. C. Taylor our Counsel has been north for some time, he will soon return to Florida and we will have him proceed with these matters as rapidly as possible.

We would be pleased to have you advise us the probable cost of such necessary preliminaries as you may require.
