Dear Mr. Jaudon:

I have your letter of July 20, with reference to the Florida railroad enterprise, and the matter of your land in the vicinity of Everglades.

It is too soon for the Jones estate or The Sunday Creek Coal Company to enter into any matters of this kind. In fact, so far as the Jones estate is concerned, I think the trustees are without authority to enter into an arrangement of this kind.

As to whether or not it could be brought about through some of the underlying companies is a matter that will require careful thought, and I think it is safe to say that we would not be in position to undertake a matter of this kind for a year or two at least.
