PEAT

Referring to yours of August 27th:

We quite fully understand what you would have us consider. Had we failed in our letter to you of August 13th to convey our position in the matter we will state that regardless of the merit of the peat deposits or the revenues that might be derived from utilizing same, we do not have a requirement to use that commodity in sufficient quantities to cause us to become interested in that locality, nor would we care to launch into a business of making power and selling same regardless of the financial consideration, as we desire to confine our efforts to the motor industry.

Please feel, however, that a visit from any of the people interested in your state is always welcome at our works here in Detroit.
