My dear Captain:


Your letter of the 29th ultimo with copy to Mr. Jones received, and I want to thank you for the clippings that you sent. It must have been a rather interesting meeting.

The whole thing to my mind seems to hinge on how early the State Highway Commission will build the stub line from Collier's work down to Monroe County line. The rest of it, with your energy and the determination of the Miami people, will surely accomplish what is desired. Another thing to be considered apparently would be how much work might be placed on that part of the Trail in Dade County to carry traffic pending permanent work. More or less discouraging reports have been sent out, some to the effect that the only means of getting over the last eight or ten miles in Dade County is with a hydroplane or something of that kind. Surely with the work that you have done in Monroe County and apparently no question as to the so-called "southern route" having been agreed upon as the Trail, the work should be carried on via that route.

You know where we stand in the matter. I have no doubt you will hear from Mr. Jones soon.
