My dear Captain Collier:-

I did not receive a reply from you of your receipt of my wire sent to you on April 25th. I presume my message was not relayed to you by telephone from Fort Myers.

The reason I wanted the information requested was that the Chamber of Commerce of Miami held an open forum meeting on Monday night relative to the Tamiami Trail and I simply wanted to show there were other tax payers in Collier County other than Barron G. Collier, and that the several tax payers desired that the Collier County end of the Tamiami Trail and the Monroe County end of the Tamiami Trail be connected at the earliest possible moment, and give the public the benefit and use of this important cross state highway, rather than wait two or three years to have Mr. Collier and Collier County construct the additional fourteen miles of northern Collier County. I know that you are in accord with this and I am sending you some clippings from the Miami newspapers reporting the result of the Monday night meeting.

I would like to hear from you on the subject.
