Dear Sir:-

I am sending you by todays' mail, under separate cover, a blue print of the located line of the portion of the Tamiami Highway in Lee County, or rather of that part of the Highway which is now under construction; as you will note, it leaves the part of the Highway between Fort Myers and Marco (already graded and bridged and hard surfaced as far as Naples) at or near the 49 mile post (four miles from Marco) and runs in a south easterly direction to the County line where it will connect with the road being built from Miami. I have not been able to send this print to you sooner, because I had to order the print paper and besides, have been buisy with other matters. A little over twelve miles of this road is now graded and the prospects are that the construction will go ahead very much more rapidly from now on due to some changes which ha ve been made by the contractor.

The bill for the print is \$1.50.
