Also acknowledging receipt of your profile of soundings and level, which I am returning to you by registered mail. I am also enclosing my check for \$1.50, and I certainly thank you for your accommodations in both matters.

I am working out a plan to take advantage of the states donation of land to create an excavation paralleling Lee County's part of the Tamiami Trail, which will produce the said excavation and rock to hard surface the road and I feel that I will be able to offer something practical in a very short time.

I certainly am glad that they are pushing the construction from "Andersons Creek east as rapidly as possible and it is my great hope that Messrs James and Green can be induced to put on a second machine at Allen or Turners river and push the construction so that it can be completed by January 12th, 1919, as per schedule.
