I guess you will have to send us some money for it is almost the first of the month and we will have to pay up our bills the first.

we have set the bean and the old squash patches in tomatoes this week and finished fertilizing the tomatoes and fixing the watermelon land and will try and get it planted this week we have had two negroes all the week and will have to have help next week to help set the Ferris field we want to start on it Monday and get it in as soon as possible so I can get to go to Everglade and I want to do that next week so I can go to Orlando when you want me to.

so send us about one hundred if you can .

say by the way I have been making hills for the cukes today and I will plant them tomorrow and try them out every thing is looking fine and if it just dont freeze we cant help but make good on something I think,

Say about that bill to the Alexander -Ramsey- Keer Co Mr C.M. Collier is telling it around Town or at least Mr Barnes was up here tonight and said that Mr C.M. Collier told him all about it and told him that he did not see how you could expect them to pay it and he did not think that they would pay it, so I wanted you to know how he was treating the matter and how he was going and talking it to out siders, I always thought that Mr Collier always tried to keep the out side world from knowing his business but it looks like that Mr C.M. Collier is trying to advertize you as a poor business man and it sure do not set well with me.

Mr scott did not come up wednesday but will be up tomorrow I hear and Mr C.M. Collier will be back with him so I will see them then and find out what Mr Scott has to say and also make a date to go after the things at Everglade.

Will write you as things shows up here to cause any excitement, hopping you found Mrs Jaudon greatly improved and every thing getting along O.K. in Miami when you returned.
