### FRANKLIN WESTS DIARY

while searching for Kings Party.

WEDNESDAY March 7th. 1917. ---Camped one mile south of the Tamiami Trail, approximately sixteen miles West of Miami. Water very low. Had to drag our boat most of the way. Water increased three inches over night--caused by heavy rains. Met Seminole Indian Willie Willie at noon. He has not heard anything of the lost party. Made camp at sun down.

FRIDAY March 9th. Broke camp early and moved West. Aeroplane circled over about 9:30 A.M. Passed deserted Indian camp at noon, consisting of three shingle roofed and two thatched roof shanties. Made camp at dark on large hammock. We did not meet any human beings today. Occasionally a blue heron would flop up and fade away in the dim distance.

SATURDAY March 10. Passed Johnnie Willies Indian village at 9:00. None of the indians had heard of or seen the lost party. At noon we met three Indians coming from big cypress. They had neither heard nor seen the King party. Went to John Tigers camp 12:30 P.M. Found only an Indian boy. He could tell us nothing except that Tiger Tail had gone south towards Shark River looking for the lost men. We kept up smook signals, At 4.00 we sighted smook far in to the south towards Shark River. We also saw smook in the East, which we judged not to be over five or six miles from the Dredge McCrary.

SUNDAY March 11th. Met Foot Cypress and one other Indian at sun down--they could give us no information.

MONDAY, March 12th. Did not meet anyone today. Camped about three miles of Big Cypress, approximately Miami latitude.

TUESDAY, March 13th. Went to Chas Tiger Tails camp. He could give us no information. We continued West into Big Cypress but did not find any evidence of Kings and party.
