

Ordinance #108

AN ORDINANCE of the City Council of the City of Miami Beach, Florida, regulating the use of Golf Links and Club Houses operated in connection therewith, and providing a penalty for the violation hereof,

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Miami Beach, Florida:

Section 1. That from and after the passage of this ordinance, and its publication as required by law, it shall be unlawful for any person, or persons, to go upon the permises or links of any golf course, located within the City limits of the City of Miami Beach, Florida, or for any such person, or persons, to go in or about any club house operated in connection with any such golf course, or for any such person, or persons, to use any golf sticks, golf balls, or other equipment used in connection with any such golf course; provided, however, that the provisions hereof shall not apply to any person, or persons, members of such golf club operated in connection with said golf course, or the invited guest, or guests of any member of such golf club, or to any other person, or persons going upon such golf course, or into such club house at the invitation of the management of such golf course or club house.

Section 2. Any person, or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Fifty Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding thirty days.

Section 3. That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed.
