AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA, CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY FOR THEIR APPROVAL
OR REJECTION THE QUESTION OF WHETHER OR NOT THAT CERTAIN ORDINANCE
PASSED AND ADOPTED THE 6TH DAY OF MARCH, 1917, and ENTITLED "AN
ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE MIAMINELECTRIC LIGHT & POWER COMPANY,
ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE FRANCHISE, RIGHT AND PRIVILEGE
FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY YEARS TO CONSTRUCT, ACQUIRE, OWN, MAINTAIN
AND OPERATE ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER LINES, TO MAKE REASONABLE
RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF THEM, TO
MAKE, CHARGE AND COLLECT RATES FOR ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER
FURNISHED, AND TO HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY AND USE OF THE PUBLIC
STREETS IN THE TOWN OF MIAMI BEACH AND VICINITY, "SHALL BECOME
A LAW OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING THE METHOD
OF HOLDING SUCH ELECTION.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Miami Beach, Florida, march 671977

(then the Town of Miami Beach, Florida) passed and adopted that certain ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE MIAMI ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE FRANCHISE, RIGHT AND PRIVILEGE FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY YEARS TO CONSTRUCT, ACQUIRE, OWN, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER LINES, TO MAKE REASONABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF THEM, TO MAKE, CHARGE AND COLLECT RATES FOR ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER FURNISHED, AND TO HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY AND USE OF THE PUBLIC STREETS IN THE TOWN OF MIAMI BEACH AND VICINITY,"

and

Whereas, under Section 29 of the Charter of said City of
Miami Beach, Florida, it is provided that no ordinance granting
the right to use the streets or alleys of the City of Miami
Beach to any private person or corporation shall become a law
until the same has been approved by a majority of the qualified
voters of the City of Miami Beach voting at an election held
therefor,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Miami Beach, Florida,

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 26 of the City Charter, the same being an Act of the Legislature of the

State of Florida, approved May 85th, 1917, known as Chapter 7672 of the Lews of Florids, 1917, entitled "an ACT TO ABOLISH THE PRESERT MINICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE TOWN OF MIANI BRACH, IN THE COURTY OF DADE AND STATE OF PLORIDA, AND TO ESTABLISH, ORGANISH AND INCORPORATE A CITY GOVERNMENT FOR THE OXIT OF MIAMI DEADE, PLAKERS, TO DEFINE ITS TERRI-TORIAL DOUBLARISS, TO PRESCRIBS 125 JURISDICTION, PORERS AND PRIVILEGES, AND FOR THE EXENCISE OF THE SAME, AND 20 AUTHORIES THE IMPOSITION OF CHEATING FOR THE VIOLATION OF 198 ORDINABURS, a special election be and hereby is called and directed to be held at the City Council Chembers in said City. from 8 o'clock a. m. to sunset on Daturday 000 08 June - . . D. 1919, 200 the purpose of submitting to the qualified registered veters of the City of Minni Beach, the question set forth in the election motion hereinafter centained.

That the registration officer of the City of Mani Boach shall open registration books for said election, which shall remain open at the City Council Chambers from 10 o'clock a. m. until 5 o'clock p. m. the 26 day of May of May . M. D. 1919, and each day (Sundays excepted) thereafter, until the 26 day of June 4. D. 1919, for the surpose of registering those who are qual-

Section 7. That immediately after the closing of the polls, inspectors and clerk of said election shall proceed to count the votes at said election for and against the proposition submitted, and shall prepare duplicate lists showing the vote for each, and against each respectively, and shall certify the correctness of the same, and one of said certified lists under seal shall be handed by the inspector to the City Clerk, and the other certified list also under seal shall be handed to the president of the City Council.

Section 8. That on the first Monday after said election, or as soon thereafter as practicable, the City Council shall convene and proceed to canvass the vote cast at such election, and if it shall appear that a majority of the qualified electors voting at said election, by a majority of their votes, approved an ordinance passed on the 6th day of March, A. D. 1917, entitled "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE MIAMI ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE FRANCHISE, RIGHT AND PRIVILEGE FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY YEARS TO CONSTRUCT, ACQUIRE, OWN, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER LINES, TO MAKE REASONABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF THEM, TO MAKE, CHARGE AND
