

ORDINANCE NO. 121-9

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PORTION OF A PUBLIC ALLEY WHICH EXTENDS IN A NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY DIRECTION THROUGH BLOCK TWENTY-NINE, ACCORDING TO THE AMENDED MAP OF THE OCEAN FRONT PROPERTY OF THE MIAMI BEACH IMPROVEMENT COMPANY.

WHEREAS, this body has been petitioned by the owners of certain lots abutting upon that portion of a public alley which extends in a northerly and southerly direction through Block numbered twenty-nine (29), according to an amended map of the Ocean Front Property of the Miami Beach Improvement Company, in the City of Miami Beach, Dade County, Florida, to vacate that portion of such alley. And it appearing that all owners of lots which might be injuriously affected by such proposed vacation are in favor of the same; now

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Miami Beach, Florida, that that portion of the public alley which extends through Block numbered twenty-nine (29), according to the amended map of the Ocean Front Property of The Miami Beach Improvement Company, said map being recorded in Plat Book No. 5, Pages 7 & 8 of the Public Records of Dade County, Florida, and lying between the north line of fourteenth Street, (now known as Thirty-eight Street) and the south line of Fifteenth Street, (now known as Thirty-ninth Street) and which lies between lots numbered one (1), two (2), three (3), and four (4) of said block numbered twenty-nine (29) upon the east thereof, and lots numbered five (5), six (6), seven (7) and eight (8) upon the west thereof, be and the same is hereby vacated, discontinued and abolished.

This Ordinance shall take effect after the same shall have been posted at the door of the City Hall of the said City of Miami Beach, Florida. There being no public market place in said City. Said posting to be for a period of four weeks.
