AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PORTION OF A PUBLIC ALLEY WHICH EXTENDS IN A NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY DIRECTION THROUGH BLOCK SEVENTEEN ACCORDING TO THE AMENDED MAP OF THE OCEAN FRONT PROPERTY OF THE MIAMI BEACH IMPROVEMENT COMPANY.

WHEREAS, this body has been petitioned by the owners of certain lots abutting upon that portion of a public alley which extends in a northerly and southerly direction through Block numbered seventeen (17), according to an amended map of the Ocean Front Property of the Miami Beach Improvement Company, in the City of Miami Beach, Dade County, Florida, to vacate that portion of such alley, and it appearing that all owners, namely, The Miami Beach Improvement Company, a corporation and William F. Whitman, of lots which might be injuriously affected by such proposed vacation are in favor of the same; now,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Miami Beach, Florida, that all of the public alley which extends through Block numbered seventeen (17) in the southerly direction, according to the amended plat of the ocean front property of the Miami Beach Improvement Company, said plat being recorded in Plat Book 5, pages 7 and 8 of the Public Records of Dade County, Florida, which said alley lies between lots 1, 2, 3 & 4, of said block numbered seventeen (17) on the east thereof, and lots numbered 5, 6, 7 and 8 on the west thereof, be and the same is hereby vacated, discontinued and abolished.

THIS ORDINANCE shall take effect after the same shall have been posted at the door of the City Hall of the said City of Miami Beach, Florida. There being no public market place in said City, said posting to be for a period of four weeks.

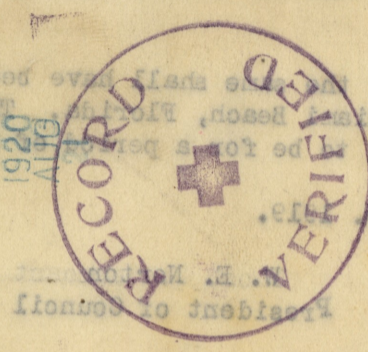
