## ORDINANCE #159

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, PROHIBITING THE CHANGING OF CLOTHES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DONNING A BATHING SUIT OR FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE IN ANY AUTOMOBILE, BUS, UPON ANY PUBLIC HIGHWAY, IN ANY CITY PARK OR IN ANY OTHER PLACE OPEN TO THE VIEW OF THE PUBLIC AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLA-TION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Miami Beach, Florida,

Section 1: That it shall be unlawful for any person to change his or her clothes in the City of Miami Beach, Florida, for the purpose of donning a bathing suit or for any other purpose in any automobile or bus, whether the same be open or closed, or upon any street or highway in any city park or in any other place open to the public view.

<u>Section 2:</u> Any person found guilty of violating this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not exceeding <u>\$100.00</u> or imprisoned in the jail not exceeding <u>30</u> days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
