

ORDINANCE #162

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION TO THROW TRASH, PAPER OR DEBRIS UPON ANY VACANT OR UNOCCUPIED LOT WITHIN THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.....

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to throw any paper, trash or debris upon any vacant or unoccupied lot within the City of Miami Beach, Florida, without permission of the owner thereof.

Section 2: Any person found guilty of violation of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not exceeding Twenty-Five Dollars or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION TO THROW TRASH, PAPER OR DEBRIS UPON ANY VACANT OR UNOCCUPIED LOT WITHIN THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.....

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to throw any paper, trash or debris upon any vacant or unoccupied lot within the City of Miami Beach, Florida, without permission of the owner thereof.

Section 2: Any person found guilty of violation of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
