CRDINANCE #174

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, TO PROHIBIT OBSTRUCTION TO AND CAUSING CONGESTION TO TRAFFIC UPON THE HIGHWAYS IN MIAMI BEACH, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION HERMOF.....

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH.

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate a motor driven vehicle upon any public highway within said City, so as to obstruct or cause a congestion in traffic upon such highway.

Section 2: No motor driven or other vehicle shall be stopped or permitted to be stopped on the viaduct in the causeway in Miami Beach.

Section 3: Any person found guilty of a violation of this ordinance, shall upon conviction, be fined not more than \$25.00 or be imprisoned in the City Jail not more than 10 days.
