AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, TO PROHIBIT OBSTRUCTION TO AND CAUSING CONGESTION TO TRAFFIC UPON THE HIGHWAYS IN MIAMI BEACH, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.....

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate a motor driven vehicle upon any public highway within said City, so as to obstruct or cause a congestion in traffic upon such highway.

Section 2: No motor driven or other vehicle shall be stopped or permitted to be stopped on the viaduct in the causeway in Miami Beach.

Section 3: Any person found guilty of a violation of this ordinance, shall upon conviction, be fined not more than \$25.00 or be imprisoned in the City Jail not more than 10 days.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES FROM ENTERING CERTAIN AREAS OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.....

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day of March, A. D. 1922.

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate a motor driven vehicle upon any public highway within said City, so as to obstruct or cause a congestion in traffic upon such highway.

Section 2: No motor driven or other vehicle shall be stopped or permitted to be stopped on the sidewalk in the roadway in Miami Beach.

Section 3: Any person found guilty of a violation of this ordinance, shall upon conviction, be fined not more than \$25.00 or be imprisoned in the City Jail not more than 10 days.
