BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Miami Beach, Florida:


That Section XI (Examining Board) of Ordinance No. 163, as amended by Ordinance No. 169 of said City be amended to read as follows:

**SECTION XI  
Examining Board**

The Examining Board of Plumbers of the City of Miami Beach shall consist of the Sanitary Committeeman, two master plumbers and two journeymen plumbers. The personnel of the Examining Board of Plumbers of the City of Miami Beach shall be appointed by the Mayor, which appointment shall be approved by the City Council and shall serve during the pleasure of the City Council of said City, and shall qualify by subscribing to the oath of office required by the Charter of said City.

Each member of the Examining Board, attending, shall receive a fee of fifty (\$0.50) cents for each applicant examined, such fee to be paid out of the funds of the City. The City shall provide the Examining Board with the necessary forms, books, blanks, tools and materials to properly conduct examination provided for.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Miami, as follows:

That Section XI (Examining Board) of Ordinance No. 163, as amended by Ordinance No. 166 of said City be amended to read as follows:

SECTION XI  
Examining Board

The Examining Board of Firemen consists of five members selected by the City Council to the County Commission, two members being appointed by the Examining Board to the Fire Department. The personnel of the Examining Board of Firemen consists of five members selected by the City Council and two members appointed by the Fire Department, which shall consist of five members of the City Council and three members of the Fire Department, who shall be appointed by the City Council and shall serve for a term of four years. The City Council may appoint a member of the Fire Department to the Fire Department Board of Firemen, provided that such member is a member of the Fire Department and has been appointed by the City Council to the Fire Department Board of Firemen.

-er. Each member of the Examining Board, after being elected, shall receive \$50.00 per month for expenses of examination. The City Council may appoint a member of the Fire Department to the Fire Department Board of Firemen, provided that such member is a member of the Fire Department and has been appointed by the City Council to the Fire Department Board of Firemen.
