

ORDINANCE NO. 191

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT ALLEY EXTENDING IN A NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY DIRECTION THROUGH BLOCK 21, ACCORDING TO AN EMENDED MAP OF THE OCEAN FRONT PROPERTY OF THE MIAMI BEACH IMPROVEMENT COMPANY, WHICH AMENDED MAP IS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 5, AT PAGES 7 AND 8 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA.....

WHEREAS this body has been petitioned by the owners of certain lots abutting upon the aforesaid public alley to vacate such alley, and

WHEREAS said alley through said block has never been improved by the City, or the dedication thereof accepted by said City, and

WHEREAS other public highways exist in proximity to the aforesaid alley, that it is useless and the expense of improving thereof is unnecessary for the public convenience, and whereas said alley has never been kept by Ocean Front individuals and used by the public as a public highway,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Miami Beach, Florida:

Section 1: That that certain alley which extends in a northerly and southerly direction through Block 21, according to an Amended Map of the Ocean Front property of the Miami Beach Improvement Company as said alley and said block is shown on a plat recorded in Plat Book 5, at Pages 7 and 8 of the Public Records of Dade County, Florida, be and the same is closed, vacated and discontinued as an alley or public highway and said alley in said city is abandoned.

Passed and adopted this 18th day of April, A. D., 1923.

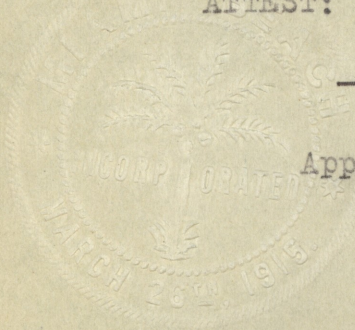
