

ORDINANCE NO. 193

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH REQUIRING EVERY BUILDING OR STRUCTURE TO CONNECT WITH SEWER LINE AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Miami Beach, Florida:

Section 1. That every building or structure within the City of Miami Beach, Florida, located within one hundred fifty feet of a sewer pipe or drain shall be connected with such sewer pipe or drain, which connection shall be by a pipe not less than four inches in diameter, extending from such building or structure to the street line and by pipe not less than six inches in diameter, leading from the street line to the sewer in the street; provided however, that when two or more building are owned by the same person or persons within a space of one hundred feet frontage on any street, such person or persons may connect with such sewer pipe by or through on pipe line of the dimensions above mentioned.

Section 2. It is hereby made the duty of any person or persons living within a building or structure within one hundred fifty feet of a sewer pipe line to make connection therewith as hereinbefore provided for, and where such sewer pipe exists within the distance as aforesaid, such connection shall be made notwithstanding a connection with a septic tank shall then be in existence.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the plumbing inspector of said City to notify every person or persons occupying a building or structure located within one hundred fifty feet of a sewer pipe, to connect the plumbing of such building with such sewer pipe by giving a notice that such connection is required.

Section 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance or who shall, upon notice, fail to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance within ten days shall, upon conviction, be fined not more than Two Hundred Dollars or be imprisoned in the City Jail not more than ninety, days, and every day that any such

person shall violate any provision of this Ordinance or fail to comply with any of the provisions heréof, shall be deemed a second and distinct offence.

Section 5. All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and this Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
