AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI  
BEACH, FLORIDA, WITH REFERENCE TO  
THE SIGNING OF WARRANTS OR VOUCHERS  
OF SAID CITY.....

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI  
BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That vouchers, warrants or checks of the  
City of Miami Beach, Florida, shall be signed by, and the  
funds of said City be disbursed upon the signatures of the  
City Manager and the City Clerk, provided that in the absence  
from the city of the City Manager, the President of the City  
Council or the Finance Committeeman may sign in his place  
instead.

Section 2. That the form of such voucher shall be in  
substantially the form heretofore provided by ordinance.

Section 3: That any part of an ordinance in conflict  
herewith be and the same is hereby repealed.


